1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and by the INSA class rules. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitors Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4. Sailors racing Harbor 20 need not to wear a lifejacket.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all female Sabot C3-A, Lasers, CFJs and any other class with 4 or more boats.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting an entry form and paying the entry fee at www.liyc.net by 5:00pm one day prior to the event to avoid a late fee. All entries received after 5:00pm, Thursday, July 13 will be subject to a \$10 late fee. In person day of registration will be accepted. All entry fees are nonrefundable.

3. ENTRY FEE

\$15 Sabots, Lasers & Teras

\$20 CFJs, Fevas, & Lido 14s

\$25 Harbor 20

(\$10 Late fee for all day of entries, online registration closes 5:00pm 07/13/2017)

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1 Mandatory Check –In: All competitors must check in Friday, July 14 between 1030-1115. A competitor must check in prior to the Mandatory Skipper's Meeting.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions will be provided during check-in on the day of the event.

6. VENUE AND COURSES

- 6.1 Boat launching: Coach Boats may be launched at Genoa West (please contact Sailing Director for more information).
- 6.2 Racing will take place in the Lido Channel or in the Harbor east of LIYC Dock. Street parking is available; please do not park in front of garages or in red zones.
- 6.3 Courses may be windward-leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 The low point system appendix A of the RRS.
- 7.2 The regatta format will be determined at the close of registration. It will be based on the number of entries in each fleet and the forecasted weather conditions.
- 7.3 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.4 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8. TROPHIES

- 8.1 Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after racing on Friday, July 14, 2017.

9. DISCLAIMER

- 9.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
