**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**Friday, July 13, 2018**



**1. RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and by the Class rules for eligible classes. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitors Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This modifies RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4. Sailors racing Harbor 20 need not to wear a lifejacket.

**2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all female Sabot C3-A, and H20's.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting an entry form and paying the entry fee at [www.liyc.net](http://www.liyc.net) by 5:00pm one day prior to the event to avoid a late fee. All entries received after 5:00pm, Thursday, July 12 will be subject to a \$10 late fee. In person, day of registration will be accepted. All entry fees are non-refundable.

**3. ENTRY FEE**

\$15 Sabots and \$20 H20's  
(\$10 Late fee for all day of entries, online registration closes 5:00pm 07/12/2018)

**4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

Check-In: Competitors may check in the day of racing, and registrations will be accepted, in person, at LIYC, from 11:15am to 12:15pm. Course charts and SI's will be online and available at LIYC registration desk.

Competitors Meeting: 12:15pm

First Warning: 1:00pm

No races will start after 1600

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 5.1 Sailing Instructions will be online the evening before and available at LIYC on the day of the event.

**6. VENUE AND COURSES**

- 6.1 Race venue will be announced at the competitors meeting.
- 6.2 Courses will be provided in Attachment A of the sailing instructions.

**7. SCORING**

- 7.1 The low point system appendix A of the RRS.
- 7.2 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.3 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

**8. TROPHIES**

8.1 Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after racing.

**9. DISCLAIMER**

9.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
