Young Sailors (~5-6 years old)

STARFISH CLASS

2 Week Sessions during June 24-Aug 1
M-TH | 9:00am-12:00pm

Class Fee: \$350 per session

Requirement: MUST turn 5 years old in 2019 and completed a Pre-K program; NO BOAT REQUIRED; Limited Space Available

The Starfish class provides a fun-filled introduction to a lifetime of sailing. This class introduces water safety and very basic sailing skills using a game-inspired curriculum. Weekly activities include: arts & crafts, games on the beach and sailing. The class goal is for young sailors to feel comfortable on and around the water.

SEA URCHIN CLASS

2 Week Sessions during June 24-Aug 1
M-TH | 9:00am-12:00pm

Class Fee: \$350 per session

Requirement: MUST HAVE completed Kindergarten; NO BOAT REQUIRED; Limited Space Available

The Sea Urchin class focuses on getting young sailors comfortable on a boat and having fun on and off the water. The class teaches the very beginning aspects of sailing, for example: the parts of the boat, finding wind direction, learning how to trim and ease the sail as well as learning how to steer with a tiller. An instructor accompanies a small group of students in a Harbor 20, CFJ, or Sabot and sails around the Harbor daily. This class also includes many land-based activities, such as: knot tying, arts & crafts, and sailing games. This is a great class for introducing young kids to sailing.

Non-Racing Classes

NOVICE CLASS: Beginner

Boat Optional; Personal Boats Welcome

Session 1: June 24-July 11 | M-TH

Session 2: July 15-Aug 1 | M-TH

Full Days 9:00am-3:00pm | \$750 per session

Requirements: MUST have completed 1st Grade

This is an all-encompassing, fun-filled class for the first time sailor to learn the sailing basics. The Novice Class will introduce sailors to: boat parts, rigging, knots, and basic sailing skills. The goal of this class will be to work toward sailing independently.

Both sessions are strongly recommended!

ADVANCED BEGINNER SABOT: Pre-C3

Session 1: June 24-July 11 | M-TH

Session 2: July 15-Aug 1 | M-TH

Full Days 9:00am-4:00pm | \$750 per session

Requirement: Must provide a properly rigged Naples Sabot, have completed Novice Class, and can sail independently.

This class is designed for students who have sailed, mastered the basics and can *sail independently*. This is a skill-building class—reinforcing fundamentals and building upon sailing confidence. Sailors are introduced to racing, for example: sailing around a course, understanding the starting sequence, and learning more about the wind. This is perfect for sailors who have completed the Novice class but are not quite ready for C3 Racing. This class will solidify independence and introduce sailors to racing in a fun, nurturing environment.

ADVENTURE CLASS:

Session 1: June 24-July 11 | M-TH 1:00pm-4:30pm

Session 2: July 15- Aug 1 | M-TH 1:00pm-4:30pm

Class Fee: \$600 per session

Requirement: 11-17 yrs old; No boat required

This class is perfect for sailors who want to seek on-the-water adventure through sailing. Sailors will have the opportunity to use a variety of vessels such as: Laser, CFJ, Harbor 20, kayaks, and paddleboards and participate in field trips around the harbor.

Racing Classes

SABOT RACING: Sabot C3

June 24-Aug 1 | M-TH

Full Days 9:00am-4:00pm | \$1,250

Requirement: Must have completed Advanced Beginner and provide a properly rigged Naples Sabot.

The Sabot C3 class covers beginning race tactics, sail trim, boat handling, and the Racing Rules of Sailing. Boat handling and seamanship will be developed, while maintaining fun as the primary goal. Sailors will be racing in the afternoons during the week according to the Balboa Bay Fleet schedule. Sailors are also encouraged to participate in local weekend regattas.

ADVANCED SABOT RACING: C2, C1, B, & A

June 24-Aug 1 | M-TH

Full Days: 9:00am-4:30pm | \$1,250

Requirement: Balboa Bay Fleet move up rules

This Advanced Sabot Racing class builds upon racing tactics, boat handling, the Racing Rules of Sailing, and introduces higher level concepts, such as: using sail controls, body weight, and sail theory to fine tune and improve speed. Sailors will be racing in the afternoons during the week according to the Balboa Bay Fleet schedule. Racers are strongly encouraged to participate in local and away weekend regattas, including Sabot Nationals August 5-8 at NHYC.

CFJ RACING:

June 24-Aug 1 | M-TH

Racing: 10:00am-5:00pm | \$1,400

Requirement: 12-18 years old and/or weigh 110+ lbs; NO BOAT REQUIRED

This CFJ class is offered to beginner, intermediate, or advanced racers interested in double-handed sailing. Sailors have the opportunity to learn both the skipper and crew positions. Classes focus on rigging, boat handling, sail trim, introduction to spinnakers, and racing tactics. This class is a great opportunity for sailors who are planning to participate in high school sailing or the 420 program in the future.

NEW! 420 RACING:

June 24-Aug 9: Schedule varies \$1400 + expenses

Requirement: Invitation only, inquire to BCYC for approval

LIYC/BCYC 420 race team. Practices will be out of BCYC. Two tracks offered: local and travel for intermediate and advanced sailors.
