1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and by the INSA class rules. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitor's Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4 will be changed as follows: USCG approved PFDs shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown.

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all female Sabot C3-A, Lasers, and any other single-handed class with 4 or more boats. Additional fleets may be eligible to participate with written request and approval from Lido Isle Yacht Club's Sailing Director.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting an entry form and paying the entry fee at www.liyc.net by 5:00pm one day prior. There will be no in-person registration. All entry fees are nonrefundable.

3 FEES

- 3.1 Required fees are as follows:

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be available on the regatta page at www.liyc.net by Thursday, July 23rd.

6 VENUE

- 6.1 Racing will take place in the Lido Channel or in the Harbor east of LIYC Dock.

7 COURSES

- 7.1 Courses may be windward-leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

8 SCORING

8.1 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

8.2 (a) When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When six (6) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9 PRIZES

9.1 Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after racing.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

10.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. This year poses the additional risk of COVID-19. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
