**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), and by the INSA class rules. Any changes will be addressed in the Competitor’s Meeting and/or the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4 will be changed as follows: USCG approved PFDs shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The ‘Y’ flag will not be flown.

**2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to Sabot C3-A and Lasers. Additional fleets may be eligible to participate with written request and approval from Lido Isle Yacht Club’s Sailing Director.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting an entry form and paying the entry fee at [www.liyc.net](http://www.liyc.net) by 5:00pm one day prior to the event to avoid a late fee. Registration will close 5:00pm, Friday, July 10. There will be no in-person registration. All entry fees are nonrefundable.

**3 FEES**

**5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 5.1 The sailing instructions will be available on the LIYC website (<https://liyc.net/>) prior to the first day of racing.

## **6 VENUE**

6.1 Racing will take place in the Lido Channel or in the Harbor east of LIYC Dock.

## **7 COURSES**

7.1 Courses may be windward-leeward or any variation of a triangular or other course. Course diagrams will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

## **8 SCORING**

8.1 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

8.2 (a) When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When six (6) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **9 PRIZES**

9.1 Trophies will be delivered to the sailing director of the respective yacht club. There will be no trophy ceremony at Lido Isle Yacht Club.

## **10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

10.1 Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage or injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
