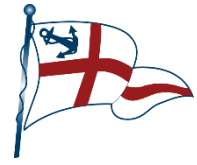


**2020 FRIDAY NIGHT FLIGHTS**  
**Lido Isle Yacht Club**  
**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**August 2020**



**1. RULES**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. Rule 44.1 and 44.2 are changed for all H20 Fleets so that only one tack and one gybe are required.
- 1.3. US Sailing prescription RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

**2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

Notices to competitors will be posted on the online notice board which is accessible at [www.liyc.net](http://www.liyc.net).

**3. CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Any change in the sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board no later than thirty (30) minutes before it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be made by 2000h on the day before it is to take place.

**4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE**

- 4.1. Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole on the dock of LIYC.
- 4.2. When flown ashore, Code flag "AP", Answering Pennant, with two horns (one horn when lowered) means, "Racing is postponed: do not leave the harbor. The time of the warning signal will be posted before the lowering of 'AP'." This changes RRS Race Signals, AP.

**5. SCHEDULE OF RACES**

- 5.1 Dates: August 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>. First warning at 6pm.

**6. RACING AREA**

Racing will take place in the Lido Channel.

**7. COURSES**

- 7.1. The diagrams in Addendum A - Course Descriptions show the possible courses to be sailed.
- 7.2. No later than the warning signal, the race committee (RC) signal boat will display the course to be sailed.
- 7.3. All marks are to be left to port unless otherwise indicated.

**8. MARKS**

- 8.1. The marks will be the AOCYC fixed marks
- 8.2. Marks "U" & "T" – When code flag "U" or code flag "T" is flown from the Tower or RC Boat, temporary "U" (a round shape mark or "U" flag on a spar buoy) or temporary mark "T" (a round shape mark or "T" flag on a spar buoy) will replace marks "U" and/or "T".

**9. AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS**

[NP] Moored boats and their mooring balls and lines shall not be touched in any way.

**10. THE START/FINISH**

- 10.1. All races will be started using RRS US Sailing Prescription Appendix U.
- 10.2. The start and finish line will be between the course side of an orange flag on a staff on an R/C boat and the course side of a nearby start or finish mark. The start and finish line are restricted.
- 10.3 Competitors must be alert for the display of their class indicator at the warning signal for each race.

**11. CHANGE OF COURSE AFTER THE START**

To change the position of the next mark, the RC will move the original mark to a new position. The change will be signaled before the first boat has begun the leg. At the time of the signal, the new mark need not be in position. Any subsequent mark to be rounded after the new mark may be relocated to maintain original course configuration without a signal.

## 12. TIME LIMIT

12.1. The time limit for the first boat to finish will be one (1) hour.

12.2. A boat that fails to finish within fifteen (15) minutes after the first boat in her class sails the course and finishes will be scored Time Limit Expired ("TLE") without a hearing. In such case, the R/C may terminate the race and score the boat points equal to the number of boats finishing plus two (2). This changes RRS 35, A4, A5, and A11. 13.

## 13. PROTESTS

13.1. No protests will be allowed. This changes RRS 60.1. Please use your Corinthian spirit and resolve your issues on the water.

## 14. SCORING

14.1

When 'X' number of races have been completed	A boat's series score will be the total of her races scores excluding 'X' number of scores
4 or fewer	0
5-7	1
8-10	2
11 or more	3

14.2. Scoring for each series will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A. Three (3) races per monthly series, shall be completed to constitute a monthly regatta series.

## 15. TROPHIES

There are no trophies awarded for these series.

## 16. DISCLAIMER

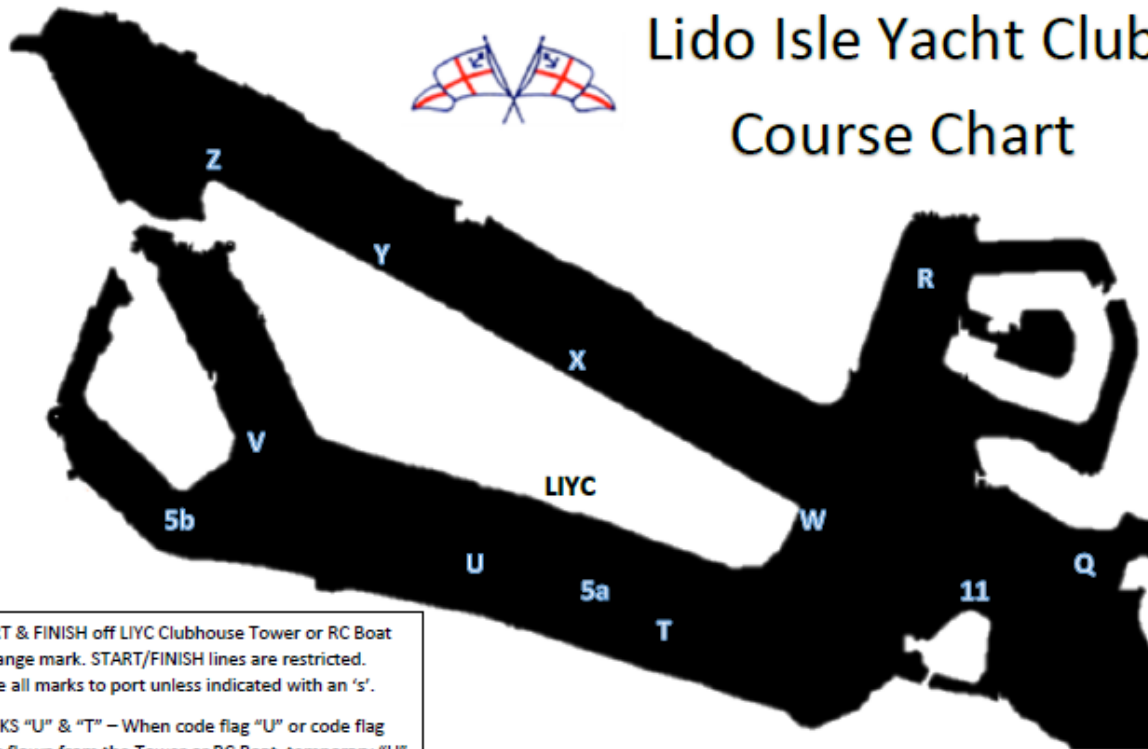

MARKS "U" & "T" – When code flag "U" or code flag "T" is flown from the Tower or RC Boat, temporary "U" (a round shape mark or "U" flag on a spar buoy) or temporary mark "T" (a round shape mark or "T" flag on a spar buoy) will replace marks "U" and/or "T".
