



**COVID-19 CODE OF CONDUCT**

I, \_\_\_\_\_, understand the importance of taking steps to help slow the spread of COVID-19. I understand that I have a responsibility not only to myself, but also to the community to take these precautions seriously. If myself, or anyone in my household, is showing symptoms of COVID-19, I will not attend the program without physician approval. If I start to feel sick, I will let my instructor know immediately. I understand that the following list of precautions shall always be followed (excepting an emergency). The guidelines include, but are not limited to:

- All sailors, parents and staff must maintain at least six feet of separation whenever possible.
- Face coverings (buffs/masks) must be worn at all times by sailors, parents and staff while on land and when within 6 ft of others on the water (i.e. talking to your coach)
- Each sailor must get a temperature check at the start of each day
- Handwashing stations/sanitizer should be used as soon as possible after touching any shared surface
- Respect and follow any signage or ground markings pertaining to social distancing.
- Clear communication must be established before passing through another person’s personal space (within six feet).
- Parents are not permitted in the boat garden or on the docks during program hours to reduce congestion.
- Avoid physical contact with others and keep hands to yourself at all times.
- Do not share food, water bottles, clothing, or gear with others.
- Arrive ready to sail with sunscreen applied and wearing clothing appropriate for sailing.
- Adhere to drop-off and pick-up schedule as closely as possible (no early drop-off or late pickup).
- Only the coaches will operate and use the hoses.
- Frequent hand washing/sanitizing is encouraged. At a minimum, hands shall be washed at arrival, before and after restroom use, before and after eating, after sneezing or coughing, and at dismissal.
- Parents that would like to speak with the coaches or Director, please email the Director to set up a time that works for both. We want to avoid parents congregating at the boardroom or distracting coaches from their classes.
- In addition to sailing gear, please bring daily:
  - Personal hand sanitizer, wipes, etc.
  - Face covering
  - Water bottle

I understand and agree to follow the health and safety guidelines as stated above. If I do not follow these guidelines, I understand that I will be subject to the following consequences:

- 1st offense – verbal warning
  - 2nd offense – sent home for the day
  - 3rd offense – sent home for the week
- \*No refunds/prorates for missed classes due to Code of Conduct violations\*
